HOW TO PARTICIPATE ON THE NET

This will be an informal net. The net controller will start the Net by asking if there is any emergency traffic. If at any time an emergency is called, please refrain from operating unless called upon to help. Check-ins will start with mobile operators first. After the mobile checkins, we will take all other check-ins. When checking in, call the net control operator's call sign, drop your carrier to listen for a double, and state your call sign phonetically. When acknowledged, give your call sign, name, location, and if you have any traffic, announcements, comments or queries. When it's your turn, the control operator will turn it over to you. Respond by giving your call, and proceed with your announcements, comments or question. If you have no information or questions, you can say you are checking into the Net and just listening. When done, sign with your call and say - back to net control. Remember to announce your call sign at each 10 minute interval. We will go around twice or more if needed, until the Net Control closes the Net.

HOW TO JOIN OUR MEETING USING 'ZOOM"

This will allow everyone to get on before the meeting. The meeting will start promply at 7:30 PM.




The KC2QVT repeater in Tabernacle (Burlington County) is now operational on C4FM for the SCERN in SNJ. The output frequency is 445.33125 MHz with an input of 440.33125 MHz. It is ONLY operational for C4FM and not FM, so no PL is listed.

From the July 16, 2020 ARRL Letter:

The first DX Engineering (DXE) Virtual Hamfest and DX Academy takes place on Saturday, July 25, Both virtual events are free. Register for the Zoom platform presentations or watch live on the DXE YouTube channel. The DXE hamfest starts at 9 AM. The DX Academy starts at 1 PM. You can now submit a USGS earthquake response form directly from Winlink Express. Open a new message, click on template and under USGS, highlite USGS DYFI.txt, then click on select. Your web browser will open to a USGS form. Complete the form and click on submit on the bottom. Follow the directions for submitting any Winlink message by posting to your outbox and open any session to transmit. Winlink Express is always available as a download at: https://downloads.winlink.org/User%20Programs/ I encourage every ARES operator to have Winlink Express installed on their PC and as a minimum, use it in the Telnet mode. I hope everyone has made it through Field Day. There were some clubs in Southern New Jersey who got together for Field Day while others worked from home. Some Clubs reported they had more club participants working from home than would normally participate,

Many Clubs have also resumed VE Testing using precautions. I think if everyone does this VE Testing can resume. Still many clubs are meeting on repeaters or via Zoom meetings. There some meetings taking place outdoors and a gain as long as social distancing is in place this is fine.

Field Day 2020 is Shaping Up to be One for the Record Books

ARRL Contest Program Manager Paul Bourque, N1SFE, reported that ARRL has received more than 8,700 online Field Day entries by mid-week, and paper-only entries have started arriving too.

"As many participants chose to operate from home this year — and given the 2020 rules waivers, we have seen a tremendous increase in entries over last year's event," Bourque said. "Most of the entries received have been through the online web app, and Headquarters staffers have begun processing the paper entries this week. The 2020 waivers allowed individual club members to attribute their scores to their clubs.

Participants who submitted entries online are encouraged to check the Field Day entries received page to verify that their entries are marked as complete, and that the club name entered is correct. Entries with a status of "pending" are incomplete entries that are missing one or more items, and these need to be completed for an

official entry. Share your stories and photos using the ARRL soapbox or via social media, such as on the ARRL Field Day Facebook group.


