# HOW TO PARTICIPATE ON THE NET

This will be an informal net. The net controller will start the Net by asking if there is any emergency traffic. If at any time an emergency is called, please refrain from operating unless called upon to help. Check-ins will start with mobile operators first. After the mobile checkins, we will take all other check-ins. When checking in, call the net control operator's call sign, drop your carrier to listen for a double, and state your call sign phonetically. When acknowledged, give your call sign, name, location, and if you have any traffic, announcements, comments or queries. When it's your turn, the control operator will turn it over to you. Respond by giving your call, and proceed with your announcements, comments or question. If you have no information or questions, you can say you are checking into the Net and just listening. When done, sign with your call and say - back to net control. Remember to announce your call sign at each 10 minute interval.

# **Ocean County ARES® News – July, 2020**

On May 30<sup>th</sup> Ocean County ARES participated in the Red Cross Emcomm Exercise, which was a nation-wide drill. A half dozen Ocean County ARES operators acted as shelter communicators and transmitted specific Red Cross forms to WX2NJ (Ocean County EC), who then forwarded the messages to the Section Emergency Coordinator (SEC) for SNJ ARES. The messages were sent to WX2NJ either via FLDIGI/FLMSG over the 449.825 MHz repeater in Toms River or by Packet Winlink over VHF node WX2NJ-10. The messages from all six shelters were sent to WB2ALJ via FLDIGI/FLMSG over 449.825. The entire transfer took approximately three minutes, which consisted of six full pages of information. If this info had been sent by voice, the transfer would have taken significantly longer and the room for error is very great.

Once WB2ALJ had the messages, they were sent to a central Red Cross agent by NJ2N and KB2RUV via ARDOP Winlink on HF. No Internet was used during the entire transfer process, which was one goal of the exercise.

I would like to congratulate Paul, KB2RUV, for an appointment by N2XW as SNJ Assistant Section Emergency Coordinator (ASEC), Operations – Digital.

Per N2XW: "Paul has extensive experience with digital communications and remote station operations. He will be leading the SNJ section efforts for enhancing our digital message handling protocols, such as NBEMS and Winlink in collaboration with SEC and others."

Looking for an inexpensive project to assist you with Amateur Radio? You may want to look into the NanoVNA device, which many operators are very excited about. The most important application of the VNA (Vector Network Analyzer) is the SWR function. The screen shot below is a trace of the SWR for a GAP Titan multiband antenna. The frequency spread chosen was 3.5 to 30 MHz. The NanoVNA can easily be paired to your PC via a USB cable and a simple Windows program can fully control the device. Commercial VNA's can

sell for \$100,000, while the NanoVNA is under \$100. If you are trying to tune a gamma match on an antenna, the NanoVNA makes the job simple.
